Bali is a province of Indonesia. The province covers a few small neighbouring islands as well as the isle of Bali. The main island is located in the western most end of the lesser Sunda Islands. laying between Java to the west and Lombok to the east. It is one of the 34 provinces with the provincial capital at Denpasar towards the south of the island.

With a population recorded as 3,891,428 in the 2010 census, and currently 4.22 million, the island is home to most of Indonesia's adherents of Hindu religion. In 2000, 92.29% of Bali's population adhered to Balinese Hinduism while the rest of it follows Islam.
